## STAR ASSEMBLY AWARD 2020-2021

Make sure your Assemblies plan to earn the Star Assembly Award for this fraternal year. As a reminder, here are the requirements for this Award.

□ Publish and distribute to the Assembly membership a minimum of six Assembly Newsletters during the 2020-2021 fraternal year. A copy of each newsletter must also be sent (either in print or electronically) to the Vice Supreme Master at andrew.lipenta@gmail.com.

□ Meet the Assembly's membership goal with a net gain of 7% additions over deletions.

□ Complete and submit the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728), which is due January 31, 2021.

□ Complete and submit to your District Master by April 30, 2021 the "To Be a Patriot Award" application. See below...

□ Earn the Civic Award by conducting a minimum of four patriotic programs during the 2020-2021 fraternal year and reporting those programs to the Supreme Master by June 30, 2021 on the "Civic Award" application.

□ Complete and submit the "Report of Officers Chosen for the Term" (#186).

# To Be a Patriot Award applications from local assemblies are due to you by April 30, 2021.

You as district master will then judge the entries and select the top TBP activity in your district. The district winners will then be submitted to the vice supreme master by May 15, 2021. After selecting a top winner in his province, each vice supreme master should submit the entry form to the supreme master. Every entry will then be reviewed by a committee appointed by the supreme knight and supreme master. Winners will be announced by the Supreme Masters office.

# **NEW UNIFORM ORDERS ~ New Price \$449.00**

Fraternally, with all the changes in the Order this year, it's vital that you maintain close communication with each of your Assemblies so they can give correct information to each member in your District, specifically the uniform, it's new cost, and how to order.

Uniforms can be ordered at: <u>kofcuniform.com</u> or 833/562-4327. The Supply Room customer service department will be able to assist with questions regarding uniforms ordered from the previous fulfillment company.

# **New Uniform Top Coat Orders**

Please inform your assemblies the final product selection has been approved (in time for our cold weather months) and is now available for purchase at the supply room.

The new top coat will be available to ship in 2 weeks from the Supply room at a cost of \$225.

The size needed will be the same size as your KC uniform jacket. So, if you take a 46 long sport coat, you will order a 46-long topcoat. Member topcoats will have three sleeve buttons, and Supreme Officers will have 4 buttons on each sleeve. They are building inventory, so orders can be placed now only by calling the Supply Room Sales Department at 833/562-4327. As soon as inventory is ready, they will ship. This item will be added to the website soon. Pins: only the PG-113 pin shall be worn on the topcoat lapel at the buttonhole. Absolutely no service medals will be worn on the topcoat. Medals are reserved for wear only on the uniform jacket. This is a wonderful addition to the uniform, and just in time for a great Christmas present for our 4th Degree brothers. Please make sure you send this out to your Assembly members as soon as possible and continue

<u>Please Note: It certainly is not required that everyone purchase a top coat</u> and we don't want to deny men to participate in a call out simply because they have no top coat. We have to rely on you or CCC to make the decision on top coats, as well as if swords are to be used.

Let's use our common sense and have those in top coats march / stand together, and those without top coats the same. Let's not complicate things.
